In the Name of God Amen The Tenth Day of November
in the Year of our God One thousand seven hundred and
Sixty seven

I John Harrison of Hyde County being sick and weak but
a sound mind and Memory thanks be to God therefore Calling
to mind the Mortality of and knowing that it is appointed
for all men to Die do make and Ordain this my Last Will
and Testament first of all Recommend sole in the hands of
God who gave it and my Body I Commit to the Earth to Decent
Buryal the Discretion of my Executors hereof the mentioned and
as touching such worldly Estate as I have possessed, I Give and
Dispose of the same in the following manner. First my Will is
that all the Debts which I do owe any person be truly Contented
and paid by my Executors hereof the named.

Thus I Give to my son William Harrison one Shilling Sterling to
be paid him and no more.

Thus I Give to my Daughter Mary Eggleston one shilling Sterling
to be paid her out of my Estate and no more.

Thus I Give to my Loving Wife Ellenor Harrison and my three Children
the Rest of my Estate both Real and Personal to be Equally
Divided amongst them my Wife to be possessed with my House
and Land so long as she lives a Widow and I do hereby ap-
point my Wife Ellenor Harrison to be my sole Executor
of this my Last Will and Testament.
