be given to God for the same. Therefor calling to mind the
mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed once
for all men to die & to ordain this to be my last will
and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I
give and Recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it
and my body to be buried in a Christian
Burial at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God and notwithstanding such
worldly goods as pleased God to give me within this life I
give Devise and Dispose of in the following manner. —
Item I give and Bequeath to my Loving son John Mason one
case and Bottles also the last whip and I bought about
my working tools of all sorts. —
Item I give and Bequeath to my Loving son James Mason one
case and bottle that I delivered him before Major July
Before my death. —
Item I give and Bequeath to my Loving daughter Sarah Mason
one trundle Bed and one Bed and all the furniture
that belongs to it. —
Item I give and Bequeath to my Loving son Thomas Mason one
Bed & Bedstead and Bottles and all the furniture that belongs to it.
Item I give and quæst to my Loving wife Sarah Mason one Bed
and one trundle Bed and all the furniture that belongs
to it also Trunk and a Riding horse and Bottles also one
Linin wheel one rollin wheel two pair of Chars.
Item I give and Bequeath to my son Benj Mason one Shilling
Sterling. —
Item I give to my Daughter Sarah Mason one Shilling Sterling. —
Item I give to my Daughter Martha Mason one Shilling Sterling. —
Item I give to my Loving Daughter Mary Ann Morris
Two pairs Dishes & two feather beds. —
All my Estate that I have not already given or away I
Leave to be Equally Divided at my Death between my

wife Sarah Mason and all my Children. — I likewise
constitute and ordain my son John Mason my Executor
to this my last will and testament and I do hereby utterly
disabuse & revoke & disannull all former Testaments wills
Signatures and Bequests by me made in witness whereof I
hereunto set my hand and seal this day & date above
written signed and acknowledged by the said John Mason
his last will and testament } John Mason Seal

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Cornelius Jones
my Back plantation wheron just lately formerly
Lod whereth there is a ditch cut that shall divide
the clearing of the two plantations which then the
woodland land to be Equally Divided between
