Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah one Dish three puter plates.

Item I give and bequeath to my son James Herbert one bed and furniture one Chest one puter Dish and basin four puter plates one box & Cupboard one basin and bottles half my shoe tools one small trunk one tray one pot one gun

Item I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Herbert one bed and furniture one basin & Cupboard one Chest one Dish & basin four puter plates one pot half my shoe tools

Also myself and Desire is that all and singular the rest of my property may be sold to pay my Debts and if there should be anything over to be equally Divided amongst them

First I give unto my own Anthony Tuley fifty acres of land lying on Mattamuskeet lake being the northernmost part of the barrens and from James Clayton to Morris Jones

Secondly I give unto my son James Tuley the other fifty acres joining Anthony's it being the northernmost part of the said land to him and his heirs for ever

Thirdly I send unto my wife Elizabeth Tuley all the remainder part of my land that I have on Mattamuskeet during her natural life

Fourthly I give unto my beloved wife one feather bed and the furniture belonging to it Fifthly I give unto my son Anthony Tuley one feather bed and furniture belonging to it after the decease of my wife Elizabeth Tuley

Seventhly I send unto my wife Elizabeth Tuley during her natural life and no longer one negro fellow named Samuel and then I will and bequeath of and with the said negro fellow Samuel to my son James Tuley
