

And further give and bequeath unto Christopher Neal Jr. and Christopher Neal Jr. and William Neal Jr. and Neal Midgert all the Remainder of my horse flesh & cattle to be Equally Divided amongst those four to them and their heirs - and if any Debts should come against me for all the Estates in this my last will and testament I shall Join and pay them Equal alike except Angeline Midgert & Mary Midgert, and I also Constitute and appoint William Neal Jr. & Christopher Neal Jr. my Executor to this my last will and testament made & ordained by me Joshua Wells Ratifying this and no other to be my Last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this six day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & three -

 & State of North Carolina Being in a feeble state of health but of
 sound mind and memory do make this my last will and
 Testament Respecting all other wills by me made. I Give
 unto my beloved wife Mary Blount This negroes Keith
 Sall and Messo to her & her heirs for ever. I also Leave unto
 my said wife During her Natural Life one negro boy
 named London one do. named Andrew then, after the Death
 of my said wife I Give me to my son Benjamin Blount the
 negro boy named Andrew to him & his heirs for ever. Then,
 I Give unto my son Henry Blount after my wifes Decease
 my negro boy Lammie to him this heir for ever. - Then, I Give
 unto my Daughter Patsy Craven one Dollar together with what
 I have given her hitherto for &c. I then Give unto my son Thomas
 Blount one Dollar with what he has already had &c. Then,
 I Give unto my son William Blount one Dollar with what he
 has had already &c. - Then, I Give unto my son Lewis Blount
 one young horse named Hardingain King I Give unto my wife
 all my stock of Cattle and all my household good of any
 kind to her and her heirs for ever. I also Give my wife one yoke
 of oxen. I appoint my Beloved wife Mary Blount my sole
 executrix to this my last will and testament, in witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first
 day of November on thousand eight hundred & four 1805 -
