In the Name of God Amen I Lewis Blount of the County of Hyde State of North Carolina Being in a low state of health but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will and testament Relying all other wills by me made. I give unto my beloved wife Mary Blount this my own Little Tall and Negro to her & her heirs for ever. I have also unto my said wife During her Natural Life one negro boy named London one do. named Andrew then, after the Death of my said wife I give unto my son Benjamin Blount the negro boy named Andrew to him & his heirs for ever. Then, I give unto my son Anthony Blount after my wife's Death my negro boy London to him & his heirs for ever. - Then, I give unto my Daughter Patsy Grace one Dollar together with what I have given her hitherto for &c. Then I give unto my son Thomas Blount one Dollar with what he has already had &c. Then, I give unto my son William Blount one Dollar with what he has had already &c. - Then I give unto my son Lewis Blount one young horse named Hardigan Then I give unto my wife all my stock of Cattle and all my household good of every kind to her and her heirs forever. I also give my wife one yoke of oxen. I appoint my beloved wife Mary Blount my sole executrix to this my last will and testament. in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of November one thousand eight hundred & five -
