

In the Name of God Amen, this 13 day of August 1781 Peter Cutrel living on a farm in the County of Hyde Being in good health and in perfect sincere thanks to our great Almighty and calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all to die I do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say in manner and forme following Reciting and Disavowing by these presents all and every Testamant or Testamants Will or Wills known to me by me Declaring either by word or writing and this is taken only for my last will and testament and neither and now for the settling of my temporal Estate and such goods and Chattels and Debts as it pleased God to bestow on me I do order give and dispose of the same in manner and forme following that is to say that all three debts wherein in justice to any person or persons due and owing paid by my Executor namely named Mrs. Agin and Bequeath to my two oldest sons Daniel and Jacob all the same in my last patent to be equally divided between the said End for Daniel Cutrel and the uppend for Jacob Cutrel.

Hence I give to my son Peter Cutrel fifty acres of land laying off from my and Bequeath unto my youngest son Benjamin Cutrel the land whereof One hundred and fifty acres only for his mother to have her life time or it not hindering him from Building or settling on the land when he see fit for my son Peter to make him equal with the rest of my sons in his portion of land & give him no further Bed and furniture for the fifty acres up the late Back of Lemuel Cartwright for my four Subsidiary and equal right to that and for neither of them sell or diminish any of the timber but to be left for the use of them without the consent of all. Then Agin and Bequeath my youngest daughter Sarah Cutrel three acres and Leaven a further Bed and furniture and one Summers wheel to be delivered her when so many or is a fayre and calls for them and for the rest of my Goods and Chattels to remain in my wife and after her decease to be Equally divided among my four Sons by my Executors for my two Eldest daughters Lydia Morris and Mary Cutrel I have given them their parts out in time past and dont allow them to have any more of my Estate or one shilling apiece to be paid by my Executors and I do appoint and choose my Beloved wife

In the Name of God Amen, I Mary Bolson widow of the County of Hyde in the State of North Carolina a Person of sound perfect mind and memory blessed be god do humblye now make all former Wills and Testaments I have made at anytime further declare make ordain and publish this to be my last will and Testament in the following manner and Intent.

In witness of Most Humble Requesting And into the hands of Almighty God my Master Be seeking his Most Gracious acceptance and Mercy Intercede.

I require that my Body shall have a decent Burial without fees or any Extrangance to the disposition of my Executor Intest.

I will and Certifye and declare that my Debts shall be paid first I do not recollect of ever any thing to any Body Excepting my Allegation I have Signed Sealed and Delivered unto Mr. Molignard in full Settlement of our accounts, Intest;

The remaining Part of my Estate shall be Carefully managed by my Exec & the rest proceeds Be Delivered unto Well Beloved Daughter Elizabeth Bolson as soon as she is Marryed or at the age of twenty one years which shall be at her option Carried over on next page

I do nominate my Only daughter <sup>her</sup> for said to be my Whole  
and sole heir her self and him and assigns for Ever and  
shall injury and dispose their own Will and pleasure of  
whatever little Claims Lands timber or other Estate Effects  
Shall remain to my Estate, Intervine,  
Lastly I nominate make ordain and appoint my worthy  
friend William Rupetell my Whole and sole Executor of  
this my Last Will and Testament I also nominate make ordain  
and appoint my worthy the same to be Guardian of my friend  
and to procure her good Education & Learning than her  
Estate will Therefore to Barr Shurly Colver & Certify  
that the above Content is my Last Will and Testament  
in Witness Where of I have here unto set my hand and seal  
this Fourteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand  
one hundred and Eighty five

North Carolina Being sick and weak but of perfect mind memory & speech  
Be Godde put this my last Will & Testament in Writing as followes .....

I give & devise and Bequeath unto my son Denison Holowell my plantation  
and Land there unto Belong that I had by & taken lying on Pungo River  
to him and his heirs and assigns for Ever ales fifty acres of land  
Lying on the south side of my mill pond that I bought of Mr. Holowell to  
him and his Heirs for Ever

Item I lend to my self beloved wife Margaret Holowell the plantation where  
on Brown River and land containing two hundred and Sixty acre  
during her Widewhood or life with the apartmente there unto Belonging  
also her my water Grist mill During her Widewhood  
I impower my Exec and Executor here after mentioned to make a  
Deed or title to Moore Windley for that part of my land and  
Lying in the Back paccion that part adjoyning to Cures the Land  
so & to come to the Edge of my clearing if he will pay a proportionall  
part of the Expence I have been at Curing the said Land.

I also lend to my said wife my swamp field with two hundred and fifty  
acres of land Belonging to it during her Widewhood Also Lend to  
myself wife four Negroe During her Widewhood viz. Peter, George, Sam  
and Bacra. I give to my son Denison Holowell all my stock of cattle  
Running at my plantation on Pungo river and two cows and coloce  
at my home pin and one huffer marked in the mark

I give to my two sons two Ewe and Lambe a piece .....

Item I give Device and Bequeath to my son Benjamin Holowell the  
plantation where and now lie together with the land there unto  
Belonging ales two hundred and fifty acres of swamp land  
called Pikes ridge together with my water Grist mill to him his  
heirs and assigns for Ever .....

I give Device and Bequeath to my two sons Denison Holowell &  
Benjamin Holowell my part of Broad Creek Mill also fifty acres  
of Land I bought of Thomas Smith and twenty five acres of  
plant with Joseph Hancock to them and their heirs and  
assigns for Ever to be Equally Divided between them .....

I give to my son Denison Holowell one negro Boy named Jim one  
negroe girl named violet. I give to my son Benjamin Holowell one  
negro boy named Sutton one negro boy named Jack
