 Item I leave my two Horses for the use of the two plantations
 belonging to my sons Bartholome & Cornelius Jones.
 Item I give & Bequeath unto my beloved Children all the
 Remainder part of my Estate to be Equally divided
 between them Delancy, Jincy, Bartholome Dancy &
 Cornelius Jones also I leave and appoint my Son Bartholome
 Jones & Thomas Jones to be my whole and Sole Executors to
 this my Last will & Testament in witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and fixed my Seal this twentyth
 second day of April in the Year of our Lord one Thousand
 seven hundred & ninety one Signed sealed and Delivered
 in presents of each other have witness the same.

In the Name of God Amen, I Morris Jones of the State of North
 Carolina & County of Hyde being infirm in Body but in
 sound & disposing mind and memory do make and ordain
 this my last will and Testament in form following that is to say
 I give and Bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that
 gave it me & my body I recommend to the Earth to be decently Buried at
 Discretion of my Executors & touching such worldly Goods as it
 hath pleased God to bless me with I will & Bequeath it in the
 following manner & form.
 Item I give unto my son Maurice Jones the Land whereon I
 now live and all the improvements thereunto belonging as
 soon as he comes of age or sooner in case of his mothers Decease.
 Item I give & Bequeath unto my Daughters Elizabeth Gibbs & Mary
 Jones & Judice Jones my three negro boys & Easton & Isaac
 to be Equally divided between them & likewise the interest
 which may be before the Division is made.
 Item I give & Bequeath unto my beloved wife Susanah Jones my
 Land and plantation whereon I now live till my Son Maurice
 Jones comes of age and afterwards have the privilege of living
 on the said Land during Life or widowhood. I give to my said wife
 all & singular my Estate which have not been herein disposed
 of during her Life and after her Decease to be Equally
 divided amongst my Children Maurice Jones & Elizabeth Gibbs
 & Mary Jones & Judice Jones.
 We Lastly I do constitute & ordain Samuel Silby younger &
 John Silby Executors to this my Last will and Testament & do here by
 disallow revoke & disannul all former will & Testaments in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & fixed my Seal this the
 twenty third day of January in the Year of our Lord one Thousand
 seven hundred & ninety two
