I nominate my well beloved wife Sally Stubs Executrix to this my last will and testament revoking all others heretofore by me made allowing this only to be my last in testimony hereunto put my hand and seal

State of North Carolina In the name of God Amen, Natham Spencer
Hyde County of the State and County aforesaid in person being
but sound mind and disposing memory he makes this my last
will and testament in manner and form as follows viz, I give
and bequeath unto my son William Spencer that part of my
land lying to the eastward of a ditch leading into Wake-pine
Creek to the westward of the Bridge running southwally to Chris-
topher Spencer line with said I give unto my son Natham
Spencer all my land to the west of said ditch directed in the first
legacy to the Indian line I give unto my daughter Jerry Spencer
one bed and furniture one cow and calf one wheel and one pot.
I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Spencer one bed and furniture
one cow and calf one wheel and one pot I give unto my daughter
Mourning Spencer one bed and furniture one cow and calf
one wheel and one pot I give unto my daughter Angellies
and Mary one negro woman named Lucy. I give unto

my daughter Pembroke and Lucy one negro woman named Sarah I
give unto my daughter Elizabeth Spencer one negro girl named Mahala
I give unto my daughter Mourning Spencer one negro girl named Judith.
I give unto my four sons William Natham Richard and Benjamin one
negro boy named Sam to work with them year about until they can effect
a division by sale but not to be sold out of the family I give unto my
daughter Sarah Harris one hundred dollars to be raised out of my property
not already given away after the death of my wife. It is my desire that
all the rest of my property after the death of my wife should be equally
divided between my children share & share alike. It is my desire
that the legacies third fourth and fifth should be given up to my
daughter by my Executors immediately after my death, and lastly
I leave unto my beloved wife all my property real and personal
except the aforesaid legacies third fourth and fifth during her natural
life then disposed of by my Executors as directed before in this tes-
tament. I do hereby nominate my son William and Natham
Spencer my Executors to this my last will and testament revoking
all others by me or for me made establishing this to be my last will
and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this 25th July 1816
