

In the Name of God Amen, I John Dixon being in some infirmity
bed in mind and disposing mind and making to make and
ordain this my Last will and Testament in form following
That I do give and Recommend my soul into the hands of
Almighty God who gave it and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be
honestly Entombed at the Discretion of my Executors and touching such
worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to give me with My Land
Bequeath in the following Manner and Form.

I give and Bequeath to my eldest son George Dixon one negro
boy named Trump.

I give and Bequeath to my son John Dixon one negro girl named
Jure.

I give and Bequeath to my Beloved wife Elizabeth & it is our two negroes
which she and I named Phoebe and the other Rose Likewise I give
to her all the more or less of the said two negroes during her Natural
Life or until their increase from this time. I give and Bequeath
to my daughter Rose as she is the sum of ten pounds here
ready to be paid her when she comes to proper age.

I do hereby Bequeath to my wife my Land and plantation during her life
with all and singular my goods and chattels that are not herein
otherwise disposed of to be used by her in Raising and
Educating my Children and after her decease my will is that my
Land be Equally divided between my two sons George Dixon and
John Dixon and my will is that after my wife's decease all the
personal Estate which I herein Bequeath to her shall be equally
divided amongst my children George and John Dixon except
that are then Living and Lastly I do constitute appoint
and Ordain my two sons George and John and their Executors
and my wife Elizabeth their Executors of this my last
will and Testament. And I do hereby utterly disavow
revoke and disannull all former wills and Testaments
by me made ratifying and confirming this and no
other to be my last will and Testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affixed
my Seal this sixteenth day of March 1786

I Peter Harris of Hyde County North Carolina being in
Favorable Health and of Perfect Mind and Memory I therefore
Call to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make and ordain
this my Last will & Testament in manner and form
following - First I give and Bequeath to my dear
Beloved Wife Elizabeth Harris our brother Bird and
Furniture and I give the use of three negroes to my Beloved
wife during her Natural Life named Ned Jack & Rose

I give and Bequeath to my daughter Mary Jaylord the Negro
Willow named Ned after the decease of my wife to her & her heirs forever

I give and Bequeath to my son Daniel Harris the Negro fellow
called Jack after my wife's decease Likewise I give unto my
son Daniel Harris a certain Parcel of Land Lying on the head
of North Diving Creek & being a Piece of Land left me
by my father William Harris containing 50 Acres Likewise
my fishing Suits to said Daniel Harris his heirs for ever

I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Puleston the Negro
wench called Rose and her increase that after the death of
my wife to her and her heirs forever
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Item I Give and Bequath unto my son Ebenezer Harris a piece of Land lying North Davidson Creek that I bought of Thomas Pether Containing 100 Acres Likewise my Carpenter and Jernis Tools one young mare & old Whelp an one Musket Gun, Likewise I Give to my son Ebenezer Harris one Negro Boy called Dick to him and his heirs for Ever

Item I Give and Bequath unto my son Gibson Harris 200 Acres of Land lying on Pungest Creek where on I have one Negro Boy called Caesar likewise my new Whip, Jan little Gun one cow & calf Plantation Mills and work horses my large Vaner and Sheep one Wether Bed & furniture my new Desk my Writing Apparell

Item I Give and Bequath to my Daughter Amy Harris one Negro Boy callt Sam and a Wether Bed & furniture & her and her heirs for Ever

Item I Give and Bequath unto my Daughter Edy Harris one negro wench callt Cate and her Dresser to her & her heirs for Ever

Item I Give and Bequath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Harris one Negro Girl & her Dresser callt Mercan

My will and Desire is that my Negroes shall be sold to the best advantage and my Debts paid out of said money. The Remainder of said Money for the use of Raising and Schooling of my four youngest Children Lydia Gibson Amy & Elizabeth Harris I Give to the use of my Waver Plantation to my Belov'd wife during her Natural Life and all the Remainder & Residue of my Estate to be Equally Divided amongst my wife and four youngest Children Lydia Gibson Amy and Elizabeth Harris I desire by an intimate ordain and appoint my beloved Friend George Barron Esq. my son Gibson John Satchwell to be Executors to this my last will and Testament Signed Sealed Published and Pronounced in the presence of

In the Name of God Amen, I Thomas Jordan of Hyde County & State of North Carolina Being now Sick and weak in Body but of Perfect Sound Memory thanks be to Almighty for the same & calling unto mind that it is appointed for all men once to Die Do make and ordain this my last will & Testament, first I will that all my Just Debts be paid, as touching such worldly Estate as has been pleased God to bless me with I do Give in the manner & form following - I Give to my son Richard Jordan the plantation known by the Name of old Field Point which Plantation to begin at John Capps, comes on the River running with his line to the Creek & with the Creek to the Head then with a Direct Line to the Head of a Mares callt one of the Ten thousand Mares that maketh Warrent Rapers Savannah thence Down the Marsh to the River and down the River to the first Station to him and his heirs for Ever

Item I Give unto my son Abraham Jordan the Land that he now lives on, the land to begin at the Head of a Branch of Turkey Creek, thence Running with a line of marked Trees to the Swamp and Straight through the Swamp to the Back line and with the Back line to James Webster Land and with his line & the Creek & River to the first Station

Item I Give unto my son John Jordan the Land and Plantation Beginning at the Mouth of a Small Creek at and

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
