Executor mentioned Here. I give and Bequeath unto my Son Samuel Horsey. One Shilling Sterling money as a Bar against any other part of my Estate to him and his heirs forever, —

Now I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Chambers One Looking Glass as a Bar against any other part of my Estate to her and her heirs forever. —

Now I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Horsey. One Bed and furniture as a Bar against any other part of my Estate to her and her heirs forever. —

Now I give and Bequeath unto my Son Peter Horsey One Working Hair and one Chest. as a Bar against any other part of my Estate to him and his heirs forever, —

Now I give Devise and Bequeath unto my well Beloved Son Jermom Horsey all my Real and Personal Estate which may be left after the before mentioned Legacies is paid off being such as my Land Immovable Household furniture all Hogs Cattle and other Individual thing or things that I now possess of excepting such articles as before mentioned to him the said Jermom Horsey and his heirs forever. And I do hereby Proove and Discharge all Will or Wills by me made before the Date of these presents also I do hereby appoint and charge my said son Jermom Horsey wholly and solely Executor to this my last Will and Testament, Signed sealed, and pronounced by me this 24th Day of February and in the 7th Year of Our Queen Anno Domini 1867. —

I make and order this my last Will and Testament I give and Recommend my soul unto hands of God that gave it and my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my Friends Edmund Mc Harris Whom I do constitute and ordain to be my Executor During But at the General Reunion I shall Rise up some again and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this Life I give Devise and Dispose of the same in the following Manner and form. —

Now I Devise and Bequeath my funeral Charges to be paid. Now I give and Bequeath to Livia Slade One Quilt paid there I give Livia Fort give One Quilt — Now I Give Mother's Taylor One Shyrt Cotton Gaud and one pair of Linen Gauds I give Dorcas Bell One Black Gaud I give and Bequeath to my son William Edson all the Remains of my Estate that is not mentioned either here and hereafter. I do hereby utterly Disallow Revokes and Disallow all and Every other Will and Contravening this my Last Will and Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and Year above Written.
