Hyd. County } first day of April anno domini 1794 I
Rosannah Baylord planter being very rich and weak of body but
of perfect and sound mind and memory for which I thank
God & calling to mind the frailty & mortality of my Body
& knowing that it is appointed to all men once to die do
make and ordain this my Last will & Testament and
principally & first of all I give & bequeath my soul into
the hands of the Lord who gave it and as for my body I
recommend to the ground to be buried in the ~~grave~~ ^{grave} ~~under~~
my worldly Goods or estate, I Give and Dispose of them
in the following manner & first & foremost —
I give my will beloved son Aaron Baylord & wife one
linen wheel Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Deliriance Kitch one horse one gun and shined tin —
Item I give and bequeath unto Benjamin Sander Batchelor one
Bible one hammer and pincher and rasp & one pump pipe
Item I give & bequeath to Sarah Batchelor one woolen wheel
one Looking Glass one pot potholes & trammel half a
dozen of puler sparrow —
Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Tablove Williams all
the rest of my Estate that I now hold as my property
to have, to dispose of as she sees fit — Then I leave
John Chamber Jr. & Thomas Williams Executors of this my
Last will and Testament utterly disinclining and
revoking all other will by me before made in witness
whereof I have here unto set my hand & set my seal
in presence of the subscribers
