 of age Excepting Negroes or Land I have that taken certain
 lastly I nominate Constituted and appoint my wife Frances
 Wilkins Est^t. Patrick Wilkins John Wilkins and Edmund Wilkins
 and Ruthous Wilkins my whole and sole Est^t of this my
 last will and testament Disannulling all other wills by me
 made harshest, Confirming this Only to be my last will
 and testamant in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and Seal this 26th day of September 1783.

 North Carolina Being of perfect and sound mind and memory thankfull
 to God But Calling to mind the uncertainty of Death and knowing that it is
 appointed for all men once to die do make this my last will and testament
 in manner and forme following first and principally I Recommand
 myself unto God who Giveth me nothing I nothing but let the General
 Resurrection at the last day to receive the same again by the
 mighty power of God and as for my Body I Recommand to the
 Earth to be Buried in a Christian like manner at the Description
 of my Est^t. Hereafter mentioned and as for such worldly Estate
 as it hath pleased God to Bestow me in this life I give and
 Bequeath the same in manner and forme following I Promise
 My self and desire that all my just debts and funeral Expences be
 All satisfied and paid Item I bind unto my Will and wife
 Wiltha Winsfield the use and occupation of the one third of my
 manner plantation whereon I now live During her life intended
 with such utensiles as plow Hors and one cow Item I give
 and Bequeath unto my self Belward son Richard Winsfield
 My Manner plantation whereon I now live, and all the Land
 him unto Belonging Containing one hundred and twenty four
 acres be the same more or less one feather Bed and furniture
 and the other half of my Stock of Bus that is at my Home

one negro Boy called Diamond to be Equally Divided betwix them.

But if in Case Either of them Die without Lawfull Heire
than my will and Desire is that the Survivor of them two
Should have the Decendants part of the said negro Boy
Diamond But if it should please God that both of them John
and William Should Die without Lawfull Heire than my
Desire is that the said negro boy Diamond Should be
Equally Divided between my four Daughters Ann Elizabeth
Abigail and Hannah Windfield to them & their Heires for Ever.

Item I Give unto my self Belov'd wife Will'ta Windfield the one third part
of all my Stock of cattle not by per mentioned towards the raising
and Supporting of my two youngest Children Hannah and
William Windfield But if my said wife Should Antemany or
Die before than my will is that whatever Cattle is left at that
time that they shall be Equally Divid Between my two
said Children Hannah and William Windfield to them and
their Heires for Ever.

Shal then belongeto my youngest Son William Windfield at or
when he is ten year of age and it should so happen that
His mother should be then alive and not married that the said
negro man pump Shal then remain and Belong to my said son

Item I Give the use and Leigbor of my negro woman called Daff
to my wife and to my son Richard until my Daughter
Elizabeth Windfield should arrive to the age of sixteen year.
and that the said negro woman Daff shall liegebor for the
the support of my four youngest Children above named and
if either of my said Daughter Ann or Elizabeth Windfield
should be dead without issue then my Desire is that my
living Daughter should enjoy the said negro woman and her
Inheritance to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughters Abigail and Hannah
Windfield one negro girl called Bersheba provided still
to age or mamy but if either of them shal die without lawfull
Heire than my will and Desire is that the survivor and my son
William Windfield should inherit the same But if it
should please God that both my said daughters Abigail and
Hannah Should die without Lawfull Heire than my will and
Desire is that my son William Windfield should have and inherit
the said negro girl Bersheba and her Inheritance to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I Give unto my self Belov'd wife Will'ta Windfield the one third part
of all my Stock of cattle not by per mentioned towards the raising
and Supporting of my two youngest Children Hannah and
William Windfield But if my said wife Should Antemany or
Die before than my will is that whatever Cattle is left at that
time that they shall be Equally Divid Between my two
said Children Hannah and William Windfield to them and
their Heires for Ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath all my Stock House hold Goods and
Invenables and my thinges and things Article and Articles
and of my whole Estate both Real and personal not by
mentioned but on Given away in this my Will to be Equally

 the Term of Her life to be fully completed and Ended and to longer
 Item I Give devise and Bequeath to my son Nathaniel Ebome the plantation
 and all the Land thereunto Belonging wherein I now dwell to him
 and His Heire and assigns for Ever.
 Item I give to my two sons William and Israel Ebome my sugar
 man Reback But in Case the Negro is unwilling to serve
 my will is that he be sold for one hundred Dollars
 Spouse or Hired out yearly until my two sons last mentioned
 shall arrive the age of Sixty one years of age.
 Item I give to my two daughters Mary and Caleb Ebome
 Fifteen pounds each to Divide between them.
 Item After the term of six years is ended that I have mentioned
 to my wife the first of my Estate Except the particular
 Legacies to be Equally Divided between my wife and all my
 Children then living and Lastly I do Appoint my wife
 Rebekah Ebome Esq and my son Nathaniel Ebome to executors to
 this my last will and Testament Testimony whereof I
 have hereunto set my Hand and seal this 27th of November 1783.
