and State of North Carolina Being sick and weak in Body But
perfect sound and disposing Mind and Memory and thus Calling
to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is
appointed for all men due to die do make & Ordain this my
Last will and Testament in form and Manner following
Viz First and principally I recommend my soul into the
Hands of Almighty God who gave it & my Body to be Buried
in a Decent Christian like Manner And as Touching such
worldly Estate which God hath been pleased to give me I
will & Bequeath in the following Manner, In Primis,
I Give and Bequeath unto my son Timothy Fisher the
sum of Ten pounds Sterlin to be paid out of my Estate By
my Executors herein after Mentioned My Will and Desire is
that after the aforesaid Ten pounds is paid that all my
Money or Money lent out or due to me and all my
Estate both real and Personal be Equally Divided amongst
My seven Children namely Hezekiah, Jeremiah, Martha,
Elizabeth, George, Mary & Timothy and Lastly I do hereby
Constitute and appoint my Trusty Friend Timothy Murray
& Abram Jones Executors to this my Last Will and Testament
I do hereby Disannulling and Revoking all former wills and Testaments
by me made Allowing and Confirming this to be my Last will and
Testament in Writing and no other In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Effixed my seal this 17th day of April
1783.

Thomas Hammond my sole Sole Executors of this my Last
Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
