In the name of God Amen February the 2 day in the year of our Lord 1794 Thomas Thornton of matamuskeet in the County of Hyde and Province of North Carolina Being of a sound mind and memory thanks be to God for it and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die I do make and ordain this my Last will & Testament that it to say in manner & form following writing & annulling by these presents all and every testament or testamentary will or will to be herefore by me made or delivered either by word or writing & this is only to be taken for my last will and testament and no other and the settling of my temporal Estate goods and chattels if that please God to be bestowed on me I do give order and Dispose of the same manner and follow with that is all those debts as I owe in Justice to any persons to truly paid by my Executors hereafter named—
Item I give and bequeath to my two sons Nathaniel Cartwright & Joseph Thornton the hundred acres of Land where we know to be Equally divided between them—
Item I give & bequeath to my two Daughters Jane Cartwright and Wining Thornton the hundred acres of Land

net to Isaac Swindells to be Equally divided between them also my will and Desire is that the other Hundred above should be Equally divided between my two other daughters viz Mary Thornton & Rebecca Thornton also my will and Desire that my wife Black Thornton should have her Lot of Land on her own childrens part of Land during her widowhood Life— also my will and Desire that all the rest of my Estate should remain in my wifes care household goods & chattels during her widowhood Life and after that for it be Equally divided amongst my six Children viz Jane and Wining, Susan & Nathaniel Mary & Joseph Lastly I constitute and appoint my wife Black Thornton & William Thornton & J^r Davison Executors of this my Last will and Testament & do hereby Disannul all former wills by me made and this only to be taken for my Last will and Testament in witness hereunto I have set my hand & fixed my seal in the presence of these witnesses—
