

Ebenezer Jeter him and his heirs forever, also all the rest of my negroes say Big Sam Little Sam Elisea Frederick Lewis Rose and Phoby that I have not already named both within doors and without it is also to be understood that one half of this property is when a true estimate is made that John Safford shall receive one half as a gift from me my will & desire is that my Executors shall pay over to my several heirs at law twenty shillings to be recovered out of my estate and paid over by those before named if there is anything that may be found remaining of my property either within doors or without I wish it to go to the same legatees I now make and appoint my wife Mary Bell Et together with Ebenezer Jeter and John Safford Executors of my last will revoking all other wills heretofore made by me. In witness my hand and seal this 26th June 1813

State of N Carolina this day I make my last will and testament of Hyde County find myself in a low state of health but in my proper senses give and bequeath unto my youngest child Amanda Thine Willerson one half of my land the plantation part dividing the division line from the water to the back line to her and her heirs forever. Secondly I give and bequeath to my oldest daughter Kelly Willerson the other half of my land I now live on in the same pattern to her and her heirs forever. Thirdly I give all the rest of my property in doors and without to be equally divided between my two children. Hear my friend Samuel Clark and Jacob Thorsome my Executors my wish is for Jacob Thorsome to take my oldest daughter and Samuel Clark my youngest this is my last will I leave Jacob Thorsome guardian to my two children. October 14th 1814.
