this my last will and testament in form following that is
I give & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God
that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth. We duly
entered at the declaration of my Executors and further such
worldly estate as shall please God to bless me with I will
and bequeath in the following manner. I give and bequeath
to my son Patrick Carrowan one bed & furniture and ten
dollars in cash. I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin
Carrowan one bed & furniture. I give and bequeath to my
son William Carrowan one bed & furniture. I give and bequeath
to my son Patrick Carrowan, Benjamin Carrowan & William
Carrowan all the remainder part of my Estate to be equally
divided amongst them lawfully. We constitute and ordain &
appoint my sons Benjamin Carrowan & William Carrowan
my Executors to this my last Will and Testament. I hereby
revoke and disavow all and every other will and testament
by me made & saying and confirming this to be my
last will and testament in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal 2^d day of March 1808.

In the name of God Amen, I Seth Hovey of the State of New Hampshire and
County of Rockingham do make and ordain this my last will and testament
in manner and form following that I will and desire that all
my just debts be paid by my Executors hereafter named I give to
my Grandson Samuel Daily all the land that I hold on northern
side of the road that leads from Woodstock to Bath & adjoining
David's lot, Latham's and Withins to him & his heirs provided
he should be living on the 1st day of July which will be in year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen. If not
then to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten if none such then to
my Grand daughter Mary Eliza Jones and heirs and assign
persons after my just debts are paid and the above legacies. I
give bequeath and devise all and every other of my Estate both
real and personal unto my son in law Morris Jones whom I
do constitute and appoint whole and sole Executor to this my
last will and testament. In testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty sixth day of May
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
fifteen.
