In the Name of God Amen, I Sophia Daniels of Hylle County Being sick and weak in Body but of sound mind and memory thank be to God for the same do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament in manner and forme following that is to say first of all I give and Bequeath my soul into the Hands of Almighty God then I give it and as for my worldly Goods I give as follows, to Wit, Imprimis, my will and Desire is that all my Estate both with in doors and without shall be Equally divided between my two sons, to Wit, Leonard Jones and John Daniels to them their Heirs and assigns for Ever and that my Executor here in after named shall have power by this my will to sell such of my Estate as he or they think profitable and the money arising thereby to be paid out in Cloathing and schooling my aforesaid Children Lastly I Ordain Constitute and appoint Southey Row my Executor to this my Last will and Testament in Witness whereof I have Here unto set my Hand and Seal this 31 day of July 1785.
