 Land) Signed and Sealed and turned over William Gibbs (Seal)
 and Negro further it may will and Desire that if either of my
 four youngest Daughters should die without Issue that then
 the Survivors of them shall inherit her Estate Equally amongst
 them further it may will and desire that my dear wife Elizabeth
 Gibbs shall have the use of my Estate during her natural life further
 I appoint my two sons Selby Gibbs and James Gibbs my heirs and
 sole Executors of of this my Last will and Testament and that
 after all my Debts and Legacies is paid that then they two shall
 equally divide the Remainder of my Estate both Real and
 Personal and Lastly I do hereby Revoke all former and all
 other will or wills by me made and declare this to be my Last will
 and Testament and In witness hereof I the said William Gibbs have
 hereunto set my Hand and Seal this thirteenth day of March in
 fourth year of our Independence and in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred and Eighty.

In the Name of God Amen. I Thomas Ellison of Hyde County in the
 State of North Carolina being sick and weak in Body but sound of Despoising
 mind and in more thank beto God and calling to mind the uncertainty
 of this transitory Life do make & ordain this my Last will and Testament
 in manner and form following (viz) I will & Recommend my soul to its
 maker nothing doubting for forgiveness of all my sins, my Body to be
 to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter nominated &
 disposing my worldly Estate I do devise & Bequeath as followeth
 I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved wife Ann Ellison a negro
 Girl called Tuff and a negro wench called Jenny and her youngest
 Child also a negro fellow called Jack a negro Girl called Agge a negro
 Girl called Phillis also my some more two Beds & furniture & all the rest of
 my Household furniture Except the two large Looking Glasses & my
 Book Case and Desk it stands on.

I Give Devise & Bequeath unto my well Beloved son Robert West Ellison all
 the Land I bought of John Jordan also all the stock of that Cattle thereon
 also I Give & Devise to my said son Robert West Ellison my Land &
 plantation in Long Run containing about two hundred acres (Reserving
 to my wife Ann Ellison during her natural Life the plantation and
 House in the said Run beginning at a Cross pine near the far Run
 running to the south end line) also Reserving to Charles Latham & his
 heirs forty five acres of the said two hundred acres of Land in Long Run
 beginning at the North End line of my said Land and running down the said
 Run for the Complement I also Give and Bequeath to my said son
 Robert West Ellison all my lands in Long Run Excepting three hun-
 dred & twenty in an entry I have for six hundred & forty acres
 on the East side of Long Run ridge & Excepting two hundred acres
 in an entry I have on the East side of Long Run ridge for three
 hundred and twenty acres I also Give and Bequeath to my
 said son a negro fellow named London & his wife Villet
 & her four Children also a negro fellow named Will his wife
 Cor & her Child also two negro boys called Wade & George also
 a negro wench called Jude & her Child Sam also negro fellow
 called Sam and a negro Boy called Peter to him & his heirs for ever

I Give and Bequeath to the ^{Wm} Mahon son of my Brother in Law
^{Wm} Mahon my negro Girl called Eden to him his heirs and assigns four
 Acres and Bequeath to James Ellison son of my Brother in Law ^{Wm} Ellison
 my Negro Girl called Betty to him his heirs for ever
 I Give Bequeath to my beloved Wife Ann Ellison one Grey Horse
 called Sam also a Sorrel two old Phillips and half of my share of Red
 cattle one Long Acre also my stock of sheep on the Plantation where
 I now live & my stock of Hogs in Long Acre to him & his heirs
 I Give and Bequeath to my Brother in Law Bryan Mahon three
 Hundred and twenty Acres of Land in Long Acre upon the East
 side thereof out of an Entry I have for Six hundred and fifty
 Acres lying as aforesaid to him his heirs & assigns for ever
 I Give Drove and Bequeath unto my Brother Alderson Ellison
 two Hundred acres of Land out of an Entry I have on the east
 side of Long Acre for three Hundred thirty acres being
 an Entry an Elyak Hamis plantation which said two
 Hundred Acres to be laid off at North End of said Entry
 to him & his heirs for ever
 I Order and Devise that my Executors sell at Publick Sale my
 Bay Stallion Black mare Watch & gun to pay my debts
 I Give unto my son Robert West Ellison all the remainder of my
 Estate that I have not already Willed Both real & Personal except
 my Kitchen furniture (I leave my wife) to him & his heirs for
 ever and lastly I do Constitute appoint my Brother Alderson
 Ellison my Brother in Law Bryan Mahon & my Brother Robert
 West Esq to this my Last Will and Testament In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this ninth Day
 of April anno Domini 1780

In the Name of God Amen, I Jacob Connor being very sick and
 weak in body Body But of sound mind and memory and calling
 to mind the certainty of Death do make and ordain this my Last
 Will & Testament that I recommend my Body to the ground to be
 buried in a decent manner as to my worldly Estate God has blessed
 me with I Give a follows

I Give to my son Jacob Connor the Land and Plantation where I now
 live and one Black Horse called dragon one negro Boy called
 Giddian one Black mare and colt called Guss. I Give unto my
 Daughter Elizabeth one two year old mare. I Give to my Daughter
 Mourning the Land and Plantation I got of Joseph East and four
 cows and calves and one steer five or six year old. I Give to my
 Daughter Elizabeth four cows and calves and all the remaining part
 of my cattle. I Give to my son Jacob Connor my Grey Horse called
 Hamilton. I leave for the use of the Plantation family for life my
 son Jacob Connor from selling the Plantation. I Give to
 him or any part thereof of my Will and Desire is that if my Jacob
 should die without an heir that all the Legacies I have given him be
 divided Equally Between my two Daughters Elizabeth and Mourning
 or any part thereof. I Give to my wife Deborah all the remaining part
 of my cattle my will and Desire is that my wife
 should not be disturbed from a free living up to life an any part of my
 Land I also give her one rather old and handsome. I Give to my
 two Daughters to wear a Cording and Ribbons Every each of them
 twenty Pounds Lawfull money of this state. I Give to my
 two grandsons Jacob Cording & Wm. Egan each of them one
 cow calf. I Give to my Daughter Mary Wilkins twenty Pounds
 like money. I Give my Grandson Jacob Wilkins one
 cow calf at the I had give all my cattle away before I
 mentioned my Wife my will and Desire is that what I give
 her and my Grandson should be taken out of them I give to
 my son Jacob the remainder part of my Estate which I have
 not given away I leave to be Equally divided Between
 my three children that is to say Jacob Elizabeth and Mourning
 I Give by Constitute and appoint
 Connor over
