In the name of God amen, I Rebecca Watts of the State of North
 Carolina and County of Hyde, being weak in body, but blessed
 be God of sound and perfect mind and memory and
 calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die
 do make and ordain this my last will and testament
 that is to say principally and first of all I give and
 Recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it
 and my body to be Buried in Decent and Christian like
 manner at the discretion of my Executors and as touching
 such worldly Estate as it hath been please God to bestow
 on me with me this life, I give and Bequeath Devise & Dispose
 of in the following manner - viz, First I give and Bequeath
 unto Angelica Widgelyt my horse bridle & saddle one Cow &
 Calf all my logs and bus and my Plantation Tools and
 Kitchen furniture such as Pots & put Iron & Spoons Bowls & Dishes
 spoons and all my house hold furniture except
 one Bed and furniture to her during her natural life and
 then to Mary Widgelyt to her & her heirs. - Next I intend to
 Angelica Widgelyt the use of my house and orchard & potato
 patch and apron ledges to get firewood during her life & to
 be undisturbed - Second I give and Bequeath unto William B.
 Neal all the Land that I now possess with to him and
 his heirs for ever - Thirdly I give and Bequeath unto
 Live Neal one bed & furniture my gun & skin and
