

In the Name of God Amen, I Thomas Wilkins Being sick and weak of Body but of sound disposing mind and memory thanks be to God for it do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament In the manner and form as follows viz

Item I Give to my beloved wife Susannah Wilkins all my Lands and tenements houses and all the property I now possess during her life

Item I Give and bequeath to my son William Wilkins one half of my Lands Beginning the Division line of first Branch to the Southward of the manner plantation I likewise Give to my son William my negro girl Anne and all her increase from the day forward likewise my young horse Likewise Give one half of my negro girl Jennie Likewise one feather bed & furniture one round table one Iron Pot

Item I Give to my son John Wilkins my manner plantation with one half of my lands I likewise Give him my negro man Stephen with half of my negro girl Jennie I likewise Give him one feather bed and furniture one iron pot

Item I Give to my Daughter Nancy Canner my negro girl Edney and one half of my negro boy Jim and one feather bed and furniture

Item I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Wilkins my negro girl Jane with one half of my negro boy Jim with one feather bed & furniture likewise two Chairs & a bed room and a Trunk

Item I Give to my Daughter Susannah Barrow my negro man Solomon with one and equally share of the bed covering likewise leave to my Daughter Susannah Barrow Eight pounds in money

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Windley one feather bed & equal share of the furniture I likewise Leave to my Daughter Sarah Windley my negro boy Joe During her natural life and after her decease I Give the said negro Joe to her two Children namely Mary Windley & Michael Windley

Item I Give and Bequeath to all my beloved Children after my

wife's decease namely as follows Nancy Canner Susannah Barrow William Wilkins Sarah Windley John Wilkins & Elizabeth Wilkins all my goods & Chattels in town & out after my lawful debts are paid to be Equally Divided amongst my four named Children

Item I also constitute and appoint my two sons William Wilkins & John Wilkins my Executors to this my last will and testament & do hereby Disavow & revoke & Disallow all other wills by me made confirming this to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 14th day of March 1799. Signed Sealed and Promised by the testator in presence of us
