 give them Landing and when David comes to age they shall
 have and there increase for to be Equally divided regard
 my Stock and household furniture to be Equally divided between
 neatherd daughters Both Charity and Sarah them and their
 and also I constitute and appoint my Friend living son
 Thomas Farren and William Farren my sole and sole executors to the
 my last will and testament to settle all Business according
 to the foregoing will and testament and the Law shall require as
 witness my hand and seal this second day of June one
 thousand seven hundred & ninety one and fiftieth year of
 American Independence

 Hyde County very sick and weak in body but of sound
 mind and memory thanketh God for the same but having to mind the
 uncertainty of Death and Knowing that God hath appointed time for all men to
 die therefore desire to make this my last will and testament and principally
 for the first of all to commit my body to the dust from whence
 it came and to be buried at the discretion of my Executors to be Buried in
 a Christian like manner Likewise I command my soul to the hands of God
 who gave it Nothing Doubting but near the same again at the general
 resurrection the mighty power of God and a touching exceedingly
 good oration that death please to take me with in this life spine and
 Daggers of the same in following manner and form

Item I bind unto my well beloved wife Martha Wright all land and Plantation
 wherein I now live during her natural life but after her death my will
 and desire is that my son William Wright should inherit the same
 him and his heirs forever likewise I bind all my household goods
 and my stock of cattle of every kind he to use during her natural
 life or widowhood and then to be Equally divided between my children

Item I give and bequeath unto son Thomas Wright one hundred acres of land
 lying up pantside Swamp

Item I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Wright one feather
 bed and furniture with one Cow and Land to her and her forever
 and further I appoint my well beloved son William Wright and sonne
 Wright my executors of this my last will and testament Reciting all
 will and testament Ie writing witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and seal this thirtieth day of October in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety five
