Dors & without that is not already let or given away I
send to my wife Elizabeth Tuley during her natural
Life and after her Decease I will and bequeath all and
everything then remaining that is not conveyed already
& disposed of to be equally divided between my three sons
Anthony Tuley Levi Tuley & James Tuley — Lastly I do
appoint my son James Tuley & Levi Tuley my Executors
to this my last will & testament In the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred & thirty eight —

mind and memory do this 29th day of January 1798 make and ordain this
my last will and testament revoking all other wills —

(viz) I give unto my son Morris Beacham one half by the name first head
which is all he is to inherit of my said Estate him and his heirs —

I give to my son William Beacham one fourth to him his heirs forever —

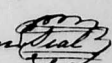
I give to my son John Beacham one Deed to him & his heirs —

I send unto my wife Summey Beacham all the remainder part of my
Estate that is not already willed away during of her natural life
or widowhood and if she should marry my will is that my two

and my will is at my wife's Death or widowhood that all the remain-
