I Give and bequeath to my will beloved wife Mary Enslay
all my estate with in and out without During her widowhood
after all my debts is paid

I Give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Enslay one feather bed
and furniture only Reserving that my wife shall have the
use of it During her widowhood

I Give and bequeath to my son James Enslay one feather bed
and furniture only that my wife shall have the use thereof
During her widowhood

I Give and bequeath to my son Isaac Enslay one feather bed
and furniture only that my wife shall have the use as above
During her widowhood

I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Enslay one
feather bed and furniture only that my wife shall have
the use of it During her widowhood

I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Enslay one feather
bed & furniture only that my wife shall have the use of
the same During her widowhood

and further my will and desire is that in case my wife
should marry or in case of her death that all my lands
and my goods stock and household furniture & that
have not been given away I dispose of should

Solomon John Henry Benjamin James Sarah Elizabeth Mary
Margaret and Sarah Enslay -

And Lastly my will and desire is that my will beloved wife Mary
Enslay and my son Solomon Enslay shall be whole & Sole Ex-
ecutors to this my Last will and Testament Ratifying and
confirming this and no other to be my Last will and
Testament to witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and fixed my seal this 20 day of April 1801 -
