bequeath unto my sonne he should be free forever

I give to my best House builded and ready to be sold disposial
also I have to be hired at publick sale.
I give all my house hold furniture and stock of every kind to
Henry Windley & Elizabeth Windley to be equally divided
between them both I leave Tonge in the care of Pearl
Windley & Thomas Windley until Henry Windley come of age.
Lastly I appoint Ferrel Windley & Thomas Windley executors to this my
Last will & testament & intituming whereof I have
set my hand and seal the 16th day of March 1796

In the Name of God Amen I Jacobus Wilson of the County of Hyde in the State of
North Carolina calling to mind the mortality of my Body from long sick
and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thank God for his Pro
therefore with mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is affinable
for all men once to die to make and ordain this my Last will and Testament
that is to say principally and first of all Give and be my soul into
the hands of God that gave it and my body I do commit to the earthly
burial in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors
& and touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God
to bless me in this life I give and demise & dispose of the same in the
following manner and by whom

Item I give first of all I desire that all my just debts shall be paid
Item I give unto my daughter Sarah Rogers one negro girl named Anthony
to her & her heirs for ever also one hundred silver Dollars in full
of my Estate Beside what I have already given her

Item I give unto my daughter Mary Robbold one negro boy which
she has in her possession named Sampson to her and her
heirs for ever and one hundred silver Dollars in full of
my Estate Beside what I have already given her

Item I give unto my Daughter Bessy one negro girl
named Rose to her & her heirs for ever and one hundred
silver Dollars in full of my Estate Beside what I have already
given her

Item I give unto my son Roger Barrow all the land I possess
except the west end of my plantation as far as the Division
fence to him & his heirs for ever also one negro fellow named
Dickie & one boy named Sutton one boy named Wm & one yellow
which named Dickie one negro girl named Rachal to him and
his heirs forever also all my wearing apparel one horse saddle
& Bridle horse known by the name of Herod

Item I give & Request unto my beloved wife Anne Barrow
the west end of my plantation as far as the Division
fence during her natural life after my said wife deceased
I give the said Land unto my son Roger Barrow to him &
his heirs for ever also the west end of my dwelling house
as far as the Division unto my said wife during her natural
life after her decease to return to my said son Roger

Item. The remainder of negroes not already given away I give my wife and son Daughter namely Elizabeth Davis wife and said Banan, to be Equally Divided Between them which &c I give to them and their heirs forever

Item All the remainder of my estate not already given, I give to be Equally Divided between wife and son Banan Roger Banan Elisabeth Davis wife Louis Banan remaining my stock of cattle Household & Kitchen furniture about money due &c

Item I also desire the favor of my two friends William Clark and John Patchwell to make the Division of my estate I nominate and appoint my beloved wife & my son Roger Banan Executors & Executrix to this my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day of April 1796

State of North Carolina In the Name of God Amen, I, Benjamin Wilkins of Hyde County, a citizen and slave after being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God do this fourteenth day of July in the year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty five make and publish my last will and Testament in manner following that is to say I give and bequeath to my son Jacob Wilkins the manner of Plantation wherein I now live containing two hundred eighty acres of land there upon two negro boys namely Ann, Will and Joe one large white man one young Bay horse one feather bed and furniture seven head of cattle to him & his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Morning Wilkins one negro girl named Will and one large boy near to her one feather bed and furniture and seven head of cattle to him & her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Wilkins one negro girl named Phillips one large boy near to her one feather bed and furniture and seven head of cattle to her and her heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath to my two daughters Morning Wilkins & Mary Wilkins and negro woman named Hannah and her future increase to be Equally Divided Between them When my daughter Mary Wilkins arrives to the age of eighteen years old to them and their heirs forever

Item I give the all the rest of my estate to my three children Jacob, Morning & Mary Wilkins to be Equally Divided between them, to them & their heirs forever

I hereby constitute and appoint my worthy friend Jacob Cannon & my son Jacob Wilkins Executors to this my last will and Testament, In testimony whereof I Benjamin Wilkins bear to this my last will & Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written —
