& other, household & other to be sold & all just debts
to be paid. If there be money left after my
Accounts are collected & my debts paid I allow it to
be equally divided between my Wife & expected Child.
If my Child should ^{die before it} become of age I allow my
beloved Wife the one half of its estate & the other half to
be equally divided amongst my Brothers & Sisters.
