of January 1789 that I Agnass Givens of Iredell County state of North Carolina
Sick & Weak of Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be god for his mercies calling
to mind the mortality of my body & it is appointed for all men once to die do make &
Ordain this my last will & testament which is as followeth principally & first of all I
Recommend my soul to God who gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian
manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but I shall receive the same
again at the general resurrection by the almighty power of god & touching my worldly
estate where with it has pleased God to bless me with in this life I do Devise & dispose of
in the following manner & form Viz. I my Executors I allow all my Just debts & funeral
charges to be paid off my estate Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Margaret Twen-
ty Shillings specie Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary one bond of two hundred pounds
in the year 1785 with all its Interest one mare & young Colt one sorrel mare three year old
five cows & three young cattle four sheep I call my apparell & clotheing of every kind my
beds with all their furniture of every kind my saddle & bridle my hille & my pot six plates
two dishes two basons all of pewter my spinning wheel I each reel & my big wheel my
Hille & cups & saws two table cloths two hatchets one black walnut chest with two drawers
with all the remaining part or parts of my estate Only under & subject to the payment of
all other legacies here in mentioned or to be mentioned Item I give to my daughter Agnass
twenty shillings specie Item I give & bequeath to my son Edward twenty shillings specie
Likewise I constitute & ordain my daughter Mary White & Samuel Hanna

Same in manner following I first do my positive will & order that all my Just debts be paid
I Second I give & bequeath to my son John one hundred & fifty acres of land of the east of my
Plantation including the improvements he has already made & a feather Bed &
furniture to him & his heirs forever I Thirdly I give & bequeath to my son Wm the
remainder of my plantation including my dwelling house & all the improvements
to him & his heirs forever I Fourthly I give & bequeath to my son Samuel my bay horse
known by the name of rock & his harness & all the accoutrements

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
