4th I give & bequeath unto Donald McDonald my son-in-law a piece of land in the ^{corner} west of the tract on whitch I live agreeable to a line run up one Prong of Turkey Branch & from that to the jumping run at the mouth of a Hollow near to Hugh McKay corner.

5th That my sons Alexander & William McDonald gets five dollars each. 6th That my son Jas. McDonald is to have the balance of ^{the} tract on whitch I live & is to maintain his mother. 7th That my daughter Mary to have one Cow and calf. 8th I give to Margaret my beloved wife two Cows her choice & my 6th Mare together with all my household furniture ^{as at her disposal.}

I Give agreeable to a line run up one Prong of Turkey Branch & from that to the jumping run at the mouth of a Hollow near to Hugh M. Kay's corner.

5th That my sons Alexander & William McDonald gets five dollars each. 6th That my son Jas. McDonald is to have the balance of ^{the} tract on which I live & is to maintain his mother. 7th That my daughter Mary to have one Cow and calf. 8th I give to Margaret my beloved wife two Cows her choice & my bl. Mare together with all my household furniture to be at her disposal.

9th The balance of my stock to be sold. to pay my debt & the balance (if any) to my daughter Mary.

And lastly I make & ordain Donald MacArthur & Donald M. McIntosh Executors of this my last will &
