gears to my wife and what furniture there is in the House to be equally
divided between my Wife and three Daughters that's Betsey. Ann and Sarah
and all the plantation tools to be equally divided between my Wife and Caleb and
Andrew and all my coopers tools and joiners tools to Andrew and Caleb and
Sammuel's tools to Caleb and Andrew Mary Ann Webb and Caleb Webb my
