March one thousand eight hundred & Sixty I David Beal, of Iredell
State of N. Carolina, being weak in body but of sound mind & memory
Recalling to mind the mortallity of my body, Knowing it is apper
for all men to die, do make this my last will & Testament in following
manner Viz. Item I give & bequeath to my wife Rachel, my
Dwelling plantation with all the houses thereon that stand a jming
& except one hundred & Sixty acres to be hereafter named during
her life natural life or widowhood, One young horse Pick her
Saddle & bridle, three cows & Calves, the best bed & furniture, one four
th part of all my hogs, one fourth part of all my Household furni
ture & Kitchen Go, (except what is hereafter named to my daugh
ter Martha) all of which I give unto her during her natural
life or widowhood. Item I give unto Son Joe D. Beal ten Shillings
no more of my estate. Item I give unto my daugh
ter Eun Galloway, five Shillings, no more of my estate, Item
I give unto my son Joseph Beal ten Shillings, no more of my estate
Item I give unto my son John Beal, ten Shillings no more
of my estate. Item I give unto my son Evan Beal ten Shillings
no more of my estate, Item I give unto my Daughter Martha,
One hundred & Sixty acres of land being part of the tract known
as on beginning at a hickory the north east corner of William
Peggarolds corner & runs north until it strikes the original line
then west with the line to Willough Archibalds corner then south
with his line to Dr. Peggarolds corner thence east to the beginning
one negro woman by the name of Agge, with her child Dilley, one
boy more by the name of James, one Saddle & bridle two feather
beds, two pillow, three cows & calves, one fourth part of all my hogs
one large peat, two peatler boxes, one dish & twelv
Plates, one Cotton Wheel & Carder, all to her her heirs or assigns forever.
Item I give all my wagons apperel to my three Sons hereafter named
all the rest & residue of my estate to be sold & divided equally between
them that is to say, Thomas, David & Ezen, Beal after all my just debts
are paid also at the death or marriage of my wife I leave this plantation
with all the vehicles mentioned to her to be sold & originally divided
between my three sons

Should any of them die before they arrive to the age of 21 without having
a lawful issue the other surviving ones shall be their sole heirs the
month of March, Thomas, David, & Razey, Item I forgive all the debts dues or
demands I have against Henry Boggart, & that he shall have one
pound after this he is now ingage in of the new field by giving one third
of what he raises to my daughter Martha, lastly I ordain I appoint
Burges Gaither, & Daniel Lewis, Executors to this my last will & Testam-
ent revoking & Disannulling all wills herebefore made ratifying &
Confirming this to be my last will & testament in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day & year above
written in the presence of:

Thomas Bell, Jr. Gentlemen to my three sons youngest sons, both
as to Trustion & their Estates
