Soul to God who gave it, and my body to the earth to be buried in a
decent manner at the discretion of my friends and executors hereafter
named as touching my worldly Estate that it may please God to
endure me with. I will & dispose of as followeth.

Item I will & bequeath to my daughter Margaret Cannon,
one large pewter Basin.

Item I will & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Cannon, one
large pewter Basin.

Item I will and bequeath to my son-in-law John Cannon,
one large Bible.

Item I will & bequeath to my daughter Agnes Whitten, one blue
covered one yellow gull four pewter plates one small pewter basin & sp.

Item I will & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Black thirty
Silver dollars one large pot two large pewter dishes.

Item I will & bequeath to my son David Black, the remainder
of my money together with my wearing apparel & all
I will & bequeath to my grand Daughter Martha Cannon,

one feather bed and furniture.

And I now do constitute nominate and appoint my son David
Black, & my neighbour Daniel Keeton, executors of this my last
Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal
this ninth day of August in the year of our Lord 1803
