case of Razors— and in case my Wife is not
obliged to sell the Land and if she can spare
it I will and bequeath that the one half be
given to David Wadette s^r John Wadette's eldest
son— I also appoint my Wife Elizabeth and
John Gay my executors and that they pay all
my just ^{and lawful} debts and I do hereby revoke disannul
and disannul all wills and testaments by me
made v^{er}ifying and confining this to be my
last will and testament in witness whereof I
