been pleased to God to bestow some small benefits of this life to me I do dispose of
them as followeth I do this my last will & testament in manner following
I give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Torrence my land & three negroes viz Eliza
Cary & Molly & all Estate of whatsoever kind I am possessed with untill her death
after that I give unto my daughter Anne Howell one shilling current of this
State & to my son Mary Torrence one shilling current of the same I give and

my son Aaron Fortner one shilling currency Item I give to my son John
 Fortner one shilling currency Item I give unto my son Ford Fortner five pence
 currency Item I give unto my son Hardy Fortner one shilling currency
 Item I give to my daughter Temperance Ball one shilling currency Item
 I give to my son Shugar Fortner one shilling currency Item I give unto my son
 Frances Fortner at my wifes decease my negro boy Carry & one half of the increase
 of negro wench Eliza & my land & working horses & one half of my wench Eliza
 Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Fortner at my wifes decease one half of my
 wench Eliza & geart Nelly & their riding mare called Calica. Item I do appoint
 that if either of my children Frances or Elizabeth should die with her that then
 the estate to fall to the other Item I do appoint & ordain this my last will & testament
 & I do likewise appoint my wife executrix & my son Frances executor given
 under my hand & seal twenty eighth day of July in the year of our lord one thousand
 seven hundred & ninety seven Emanuel ^{his} Fortner ^{mark}

 of Fredell & state of North Carolina being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory
