said County of Cabarrus & unto Rachel Bradford wife of Jas
Bradford of the aforesaid County of Cabarrus all the remainings
of my Effects that are on the plantation whereon I now reside
lying in the County of Iredell & State of N. Carolina. The several
articles in the last bequeathment to be divided either after
making publick sale or otherwise as my aforementioned leg-
ates may deem proper or in convenient to be will & ordain
my Executors after named to pay any debts I may owe out
of the above property as soon as convenient to do so. I further
legate & bequeath unto my sons George & James all the land

said County of Cabarrus & unto Rachel Bradford wife of J^r
Bradford of the aforesaid County of Cabarrus all the remainders
of my Effects that are on the plantation whereon I now reside
lying in the County of Iredell & State of North Carolina. The several
articles in the last bequeathment to be divided either after
making publick sale or otherwise as my aforementioned leg-
ates may deem proper or in convenient I also will & do give
my Executors after named to pay any debts I may owe out
of the above property as soon as convenient to do so. I further
bequeath & bequeath unto my sons George & James all the landed
estate of which I am possessed at the time of my decease as
well as the above mentioned share of my other Effects, accom-
panying them to either to hold my landed estate in common
between them or to divide the same as they find most convenient
at any time after my decease. I hereby request my son Tho^s
Hair to be my lawful Executor hereby revoking & making
null & void all former wills & Testaments.
