hath made & ordained this my last will & testament
First of all I allow all my just debts out of my
personal property. Secondly I leave to my daughter
Leah Kerr my negro girl Wolly. Thirdly I leave to
my daughter Cathrine Lee Davidson my negro woman
Winde & the little girl Windy & the negro boy Mabel
Fourthly to Ruthy Caldwell my daughter I leave the
negro girl Elly. Fifth to my son Tho: Davidson I leave
my negro boy Worr & old Isaac. Sixth I leave to my
grand son Charles I Connor. The negro boy Jack, & sell
to my son Chasine Davidson I leave the potter firm &
Hammack & old journey & the whole of the plantation
I live on with all the improvements be the same more
or less. Eighthly it is my will that each one that is here
in the list of those that are entitled to the above legacies

or bequeathment, that they pay or replace into the hands of the Executors the sums affixed to each of their names for the purposes of paying the bequeathments hereafter named (that is to say) Jean Kerr Fifty dollar Catharine Lu Davidson one hundred & twenty five dollar Ruthy Caldwell Twenty five dollar, Charles Connor Twenty five dollar, Ephraim Davidson One hundred & twenty five dollar. It is further my will that if George Davidson should Decease before my beloved wife Catharine that this my estate now bequeathed is all subject to the maintenance of my wife Catharine's Davidson also an equal portion of the legacies hereafter mentioned. It is my will that Jean Kerr should have the chest of drawers. I leave to the male children of my son Wm Davidson (dece'd) that is to say Rees John Abner Ephraim & Samuel Davidson the sum of four Hundred Dollar divided equally among them. I leave to the male children of my son Geo Davidson (dece'd) (that is to say) Halls & Edward & Jesse & John

Twenty five dollars, Charles Stearns
Twenty five dollars, Ephraim Davidson One hundred &
Twenty five dollars. It is further my will that if George
Davidson should Decease before my beloved wife Catharine
that this my estate now bequeathed is all subject
to the maintenance of my wife Catharine Davidson
also an equal portion of the ~~latter~~ hereafter
mentioned. It is my will that Sean Kerr should have
the care of drawing. I leave to the male children
of my son Wm Davidson (dece^d) that is to say Resp John
Abner Ephraim & Samuel Davidson the sum of four
