that my executors do Levy so much out of the remainder of my estate
as shall be sufficient to procure Decent head & feet Stones for
my Wife Mary Deceased & my own grave & I hereby order that the re-
maining part of my estate be divided between my two sons David
& Thomas Beard & James Wallis & John Beatty so that each one of them
shall have an equal divide of 1/3 remainder & I do hereby approve
my two sons David Beard & Thomas Beard my executors of this my
last will & Testament & I hereby revoke all other Wills or bequest
of which ever in writings where of do hereby set my hand & seal

In the name of God Amen this 30th Day
of December in the year of our Lord 1791 Hugh Bon-
man of the county of Iredell & State of North Carolina
being weak of body but of perfect mind & memory thank
be to God & Calling to mind the mortality of my body know
that it is appointed for all to die do make & ordain this my
last will & Testament principally I first of all give & recommend
my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it & my

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manner. I do touching my worldly estate wherewith it hath God to
help me with in this life I give advise I dispose of the same in the
following manner *Viz.* First I give I bequeath to my well beloved Wife
Margaret her bed & furniture her saddle & bridle. I twenty pounds in
money to buy her a riding Horse & one half of my dresser furniture
& one third part of all my Residuary Estate, also full priviledge of my
Dwelling House during her natural life or her widowhood. Secondly
I give I bequeath to my son John the tract of land he now lives on five
pounds in money to him & his heirs forever.
Thirdly I give I bequeath to my daughter Rebecca a bed & furniture, a
Saddle & bridle. & the other half of my dresser furniture & one third
part of my residuary estate. — Fourthly I give I Bequeath to my
daughter Mary Montgomery six pounds in money to her & her heirs forever
Fifthly I give I bequeath to my son William the tract of land I now
live on with all the Appurtenance their unto belonging a bed & furniture
my two Bar Shear plows & two pure Geese with with Leather Churn
& a third part of my residuary estate to him & his heirs forever.
All my Carpenter tools I leave to my son John & William to enjoy in
Common. — Lastly: I nominate & appoint Thomas Hall & my
son William Bonner executors of this my last Will & Testament I do
humbly revoke & disannul all former Wills & Testaments by me made
& I do publish pronounce & declare this to be my last Will & Testament
in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the day &
first Above Written Signed & Sealed in presence of.
