& County aforesaid being in an advanced period of life  
do dispose of the property, with which God has blessed me  
with, in the following manner. 1<sup>st</sup> I leave to Margaret my  
the plantation on which I now live to be by her possessed du-  
ring life, also, all my household & kitchen furniture, except my  
daughter Fancys bureau, bed, & bedding together with my  
black cattle, sheep and hogs; also my negro woman

Emey and negro man sed I give to my son James Hall  
one hundred Acre of land in the State of Tennessee, on  
Indian Creek a branch of big Hatchee; being part of a tract  
of land, 2000 acres, deeded in the Rev. Dr. Hall's name, his obliga-  
tion for 1000 acres lies in my hand, bearing date Feb 18, 1797  
I leave to my son Son Sam Hall one hundred acre of the  
aforesaid tract I leave to my Daughter Margaret Wilson three  
hundred acres of said tract. I give to my Daughters Mary  
Kowan & Elizabeth McCorkle two hundred and fifty acres  
each of the above mentioned tract. I give to my dau-  
ghter Pudence Hill a negro child named Hannah  
I leave to my Daughter Sophia Barr a negro girl named  
Sarah. I leave to my Daughter Sally Adams a negro girl  
named Synthia. I leave to my Daughter Jane a negro  
girl named Enice and a Sotil horse I leave to my son  
Richard the plantation on which Oliver to be possessed  
by him at his mother's death, also me negro woman  
Emey, a boy named Amos and a boy named Peter. I leave  
my big Bible to my son Richard D. Hunter Lectures be-  
tween him & my Daughter Jane, my other Books to be di-  
vided among my Daughters by my Executors. All is mu-

lion for 1000 acres lies in my hands, bearing date 1st<sup>18</sup> 1797  
I leave to my son Son Sam Hall one hundred acres of the  
aforesaid tract I leave to my Daughter Margaret Wilson three  
hundred acres of said tract. I give to my Daughters Mary  
Bowen & Elizabeth W. Corkle two hundred and fifty acres  
each of the above mentioned tract. I give to my daugh-  
ter Pudence Hill a negro child named Hannah  
I leave to my Daughter Sophia Barr a negro girl named  
Savara. I leave to my Daughter Sally Adams a negro girl  
named Cynthia. I leave to my Daughter Jane a negro  
girl named Eunice and a Sowil horse I leave to my son  
Richard the plantation on which I live. to be possessed  
by him at his mothers death, also my negro woman  
Crazy a boy named Amos and a boy named Peter. I leave  
my big Bible to my son Richard Dr Hunter Lecturer be-  
tween him & my Daughter Jane. my other Books to be di-  
vided amongst my Daughters by my Executory. It is my  
will that my negro man Ned have liberty to live with  
any of my children he may choose after his mistresss death  
And I do appoint my sons James H. Hall and Samuel
