In the name of God amen. I Hugh McKnight, Senr
of Iredell county state of North Carolina being of sound & perfect mind
& memory blessed to god for all his mercies spiritual & temporal do
this 11th day of October & in the year of our Lord 1811 make & publish
this my last will & testament in the manner following.

1st I commit my soul to god wh made & I trust who hath redee-
med the same; & then I will that my body be buried in a
decent & becoming manner at the discretion of the persons
appointed to execute this my last will. I also ^{will} that all my
Just debts be discharged out of my Estate. And as for the
remaining part of my estate of that property wherewith god
in his providence has endowed me I dispose of in the following
manner I do by this my last will & testament dispose of.

2nd I bequeath unto my daughter Sean McKnight all her clothes her
beds & furniture, one commode, one falling leaf Table, & I allow
the dresser, & kitchen furniture to be equally divide between
her & my son James, I also bequeath unto her one negro woman
named Flora & her children Margaret & Malinda with her ^{standing} ~~young~~

I shall have a comfortable support for herself her negroes & stock from this my dwelling place, together with her choice of one of the rooms while she remains single I also allow her one hundred dollars out of the money arising from the property I shall hereafter direct to be exposed to sale.

3rd I to my son James I Bequeath this my dwelling place House & Land & my ould negro man named Jack, one boy named Peter one girl named Hannah, and one young slave that has been named John. I her choice together with a horse named Rock with his saddle & Bridle & his choice of two pair of gears & his choice of one Bar shear Plough & his choice of two shovel ploughs my waggon & hired gears two cows two axes & one mallow two hoes my hog stock my gun & two Beds & furniture. And to my daughter Margaret Torrence, I Bequeath my negro girl named Niece.

5th I to my son William. I Bequeath one negro boy named Joseph.

6th I the residue of my property (save the present crop of corn cotton &c. which I allow for the support of the family) it is my will that it be exposed to sale & after my debts are discharged out of the amount, & one hundred dollars which I mention to my daughter Jean is given to her I allow the balance to be equally divided among my children viz, Margaret the daughter William Hugh Jean Rachel & James.

7th I hereby ordain my worthy friends, Tho. McPhright & Wm. McPhright Executors to this my last will & Testament.

In witness whereof I the said Hugh McPhright, have to this my last will set my hand & seal the day & year above mentioned.
