George Thompson (Deal)

In the name of God amen,

November 30th 1792 that I Hugh Ferris, of the county of Middle
state of North Carolina, being sick & weak of body, but of perfect mind
& memory, thank to God for his mercies calling to mind the mortality
of my body & that it is appointed for all men to die. Do make & declare
this my last will & Testament, & principally & first of all I recommend my
Soul to God into the hands of him that gave it. & my body to be buried
to be buried in a Christian & decent manner at the discretion of my exe-
cutors nothing doubting but I shall receive the same at the general resur-
rection by the Almighty power of God; & desiring the worldly estate
wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me within this life. I do hereby
devise & dispose of in the following manner. Item Viz.

I allow all my Just debts & several Charges to be paid. I will & bequeath
the plantation on which I now live & in several places I will bequeath
I will to both the aforesaid Tracts of Land to my beloved wife Sarah
during her natural life; & with this express Exception of the Tract
of which she is now pregnant to a male, I will & bequeath to
the above mentioned Tracts of Land to him who first comes of age
& I will that all my other Lands to be sold by my Executors & the
moneys arising therefrom to be equally divided between my
three Children; & my negro woman Sarah I will my personal
property to be sold & the moneys arising from the sale to be

Equally between my three Children, excepting my Negro man
Ned who is to remain with my Wife during her widowhood &
Should she marry he is to be sold & the money equally divided
as above I will to my daughter Maria Cecilia, my negr girl
China, & from the legacy of Maria Cecilia thirty pounds to be given
on to my daughter Maria Betty.

I therefore constitute & ordain Sr M. Connel, Junr. George Town
& in look my trusty friends to be the whole & sole Executors of this my
last will & Testament Revoking all other wills Legacies or bequesth-
ments what so ever before made or mentioned, constituting this & no
Other to be my last will & Testament.
