all men to die, do make ordain & constitute this to be my last will & testament
that is to say, First I give & renounce my sole into the hands of Almighty God
who gave it & my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian
decent manner at the discretion of my executors. & as touching such mortaly
property as God has been pleased to bless me in this life with, I give demise &
disposse of in the following manner & form, first my will is that all my ban-
sets be paid. I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Catharine one third
of my land including my buildings & improvements during her natural life
therewere her board & bedclothes a spinning wheel a pot, two cows which she
may chose out of my stock & a two year old & a yearling both heifers two sheep
& her choice of one of the horse creatures which movable property to be her other
heirs forever. Likewise give & bequeath to my well beloved son Gavin the
remaining two thirds of my land & the effects of my wife if my son Gavin shal
desire to take the other third of the land which my wife possesseth. I pay unto my
son in law John Wickers, James Lowry thirty pounds each there on his
making payment the same to be his, otherwise the said third of the land
to be sold at publick sale & the money arising to be equally divided between
John Lowry, Wicks, likewise to my son Gavin all my body clother, I give &
bequeath to my well beloved step daughter, her Brots, two cows, & the remain-
der or part of my estate to be sold at publick sale & the money arising from
it to be equally divided amongst my above named children that is to say
Gavin Ervine, James Lowry, John Wicks, & John Brooks, & I do hereby appoint
my trusty friends, Venian Steel, & James Gay, to be executors of this my last
will & testament & I do hereby revoke & disanneal all other wills & testaments
ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this eighth day of
Decem: 1794.
