To my said wife I also give and bequeath four hundred and fifty dollars to be kept at interest by my Executors, and the Interest to be paid to my said wife annually on the first day of January the principal of the said 450\$ to be at her disposal at death.

I further bequeath to my said wife one house suitable for her use to be laid off by my Executors my ^{the use for life of my property and being house} riding chair, Kitchen, garden and necessary buildings with the third part of the Kitchen household and lyebood furniture. It is further my will and desire that the negro man Harry be

oved wife I give and bequeath my Negro girl
Penny and her issue hereafter born to her use for life
and at her disposal at death. To my said wife I also
give and bequeath four hundred and fifty dollars to
be kept at trust by my Executors, and the Interest
to be paid to my said wife annually on the first
day of January the principal of the said 450\$
to be at her disposal at death.

I further bequeath to my said wife one house
suitable for her use to be laid off by my Executors
my ^{the use for life of my present dwelling house} riding Chair, Kitchen, garden and necessary out
buildings with the third part of the Kitchen house
hold and cupboard furniture. It is further my
will and desire that the Negro man Harry be
at the disposal of my said wife so far as may be
necessary in winter to provide her comfortable fires
and in summer to attend her hoaden.

Second. To my Son Andrew King I give and be-
queath the tract of Land on which I now live
entire to him his heirs and assigns forever and also

Legacies mentioned in this my Will, and also
he is to support my Wife and daughter while
single and their family of Black People as he
have lived in my life time —

Third To my daughter Persha, I give and bequeath the Negro Girl Cynthia, one hundred dollars in money, one third of the Kitchen & household ^{effects} ~~effects~~ furniture, one horse & carriage at the discretion of my Executors two cows a lot of Books and ^{clothes} ~~clothes~~ &c.

sils of every description, Still and Cattle Waggons
stock, and grain also all my debt and accounts
not herein settled or necessary for the payment of
Legacies mentioned in this my will.

It is further to be understood, and express condition of
this bequathment, that my son Andrew is to pay any
deficiency, if any should be to make up the
Legacies mentioned in this my Will, and also
he is to support my Wife and daughters while
single and their family of Black People as he
have lived in my life time

Third I to my daughter Perusha, I give and
bequath the Negroe girl Cynthia, one hun-
dred dollars in money, one third of the Kitchen
and Household ^{best} furniture, one horse creature
at the discretion of my Executors two cows
a lot of Books and hardware and Table
Fourth I to my daughter Jane I will and be-
quath the Negroe girl Esther and 300 \$ in
money one horse creature at the discretion
of my Executors two cows one third of the
Household

household and kitchen ^{cupboard} furniture and a Lot
of Books. To my daughter Peggy Beumster I
give and bequeath 50 Dollars. My Negro
Woman Sarah I give to my wife for life and
at her death to any of my married daughters
she may choose to live with.
My Books I give to my wife and children
