my last will and testament who are in sound
mind and memory and calling to mind the
mortality of the body knowing it is appointed
for all men once to die in the first place I do
commend my soul to the hands of Almighty God
who gave it and I do order that my body be
buried in a Christian manner and I do ordain
and constitute my son John Graham my sole
Executor of this my last will and testament
and as to my worldly estate which it has been
pleased God to bless me with, I do bequeath it
as follows I also do order that all my just
debts be paid out my estate In the first
place In the second place I do bequeath
unto my beloved daughter Jane Walker twenty dollars
in the third place I do bequeath to my beloved
son John Graham all my lands and tenements

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and all my stock and one Negroe man named Ruffin and
one Negroe woman named Delfie and one boy named
Isac and all the offspring of these Negroes. In the
fourth place I do bequeath unto my Granddaughter
Miss Louisa Graham one Negroe boy named
Harry to be hers at the age of twenty one
and my Bees and furniture and my Table
and Chest to be hers at my decease this I do ac-
nowledge to be my last will and testament
