 my last Will & Testament, that is to say, after all my
 just debts are paid I give & dispose of my Estate in the
 following manner, Viz. I give unto Rachel Tucker
 Wife of John Robey Tucker Five pounds. And all my
 Estate to be sold & equally divided between my Children
 & their legal representatives, that is to say Berry Robey,
 Clara ^{Wm} Bart, Leonard Robey, Miller Porter,
 and the heirs of Esther Tucker, Mary Tucker,
 Tobias Robey, & Geo. Smith. Lastly, I do
 order & ordain constitute & appoint my trusty friend
 Burgess Gaither Executor of this my last
 Will & Testament. Revoking all other Wills
 & bequests by me made. Ratifying & confirming this
 to be my last Will and Testament. In testimony

 day and date first above written.
