make this my last will & Testament this fifteenth
day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred & eight, in manner following. My

my worldly goods I give in manner and form following. Viz. I
give & bequeath unto my Sons, namely, John, David & Josiah
my tract of land lying on fourth Creek to be equally divided
between the three Brothers. I give the tract of land whereon
I now live to my Wives, namely, Solomon & William to be di-
vid equally between the two Brothers at the death of their
Mother or Widowhood the rest and all of my Estate I
give to my Wife or Widowhood, if any of my Children
should Marry or separate themselves from their Mother
is at liberty to devise to them at her discretion so as not to
have more than her share of my Estate and after the
death or Marriage of my Wife it is my desire that all
the Estate of whatsoever shall be equally divided among
all my Children. I appoint my Sons, Charles & Josiah
Summers my Executors to this my last Will & Testament.
