I give & devise to my Grandson Thomas Knox Three Hundred Acres of Land it being being a part of a Tract of Four Thousand Acres of Temper Land, to be laid off square off the Third Corner of said Tract. Again. I devise the remainder of said Tract to be equally divided among my Four Sons. Again. I give and bequeath to my Grandsons, the two Thomas Allisons, Tho. Kerr & Thomas Neal, Ten Pounds to each of them. Again. I give and bequeath to my Three Daughters, Magdalen Knox, Mary Kerr & Ann Neal, the whole amount of the sales of the remainder of my stock, viz. Horses & Cattle, to be equally divided among them. And, I hereby appoint and constitute, my well beloved Wife Magdalen Allison Executrix and my son Thomas Allison Executor of this my last Will & Testament. To all whom it may concern:  
Greeting. Know ye, That I Magdalene Allison of Hedell County & State of North Carolina being of perfect mind & memory, & calling to mind the mortality of all men; do order, constitute and dispose of my Estate in the following manner. First I leave & bequeath to my Son Thomas Allison, the Table, all the Chairs & Dow Chest, all the Pots but the new Pot & one Pot Rack, all my part of the working Tools belonging to the Plantation. Again. I give & leave to my son Theophilus Allison, the Fire Irons and Pot Rack that runs up & down. Again. I leave to my Daughter Magdalen Knox my red silk Gown. One Gold

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Ring and my silver Buckles. Again I leave to my Grand-  
Daughter Magdalene Knox, my red silk Gown. Again I leave  
to Mary Herr, Two gold Rings and a new Calico Gown &  
a black Calimanco Petticoat. Again I leave to Ann Neal  
one black silk Gown, & the Apron belonging to it & the blue  
Calimanco Petticoat, any Bed that she shall choose, and the  
Furniture belonging to it, and the other Bed and all the Bed  
Cloaths to be valued and equally divided between my Two  
Daughters Magdalene Knox & Mary Herr, and all my  
Pewter to be equally divided between my three Daughters, viz.  
Magdalene Knox, Mary Herr & Ann Neal, to Mary Herr  
the Tea Kettle, and all the Tea Furniture, one smoothing iron,  
and one smoothing Iron to Magdalene Knox, and all my  
Cloaths to be equally divided between my Three Daughters  
Magdalene Knox, Mary Herr and Ann Neal. Again.

I leave to my Son Thomas Allison, two set of, Fire Irons  
and all my Hogs, and again, to my Son Richard Allison  
the new Pot, again I leave to my Son John Allison in money  
Ten Pounds, & again to Thomas Allison my part of the  
Waggon & Gear; all the Horses, Cattle & Sheep to be sold &  
equally divided between all my Four Sons & Three Daughters  
to wit, Theophilus Allison, Thomas Allison, Richard  
Allison, John Allison, Magdalene Knox, Mary Herr,  
& Ann Neal, and again to Magdalene I leave the big  
Bible and my Chest, and again I leave to my Daughter  
Ann Neal my Negroe Jule, but she is to pay Fifteen Pounds  
for the said Negroe to the other Legates, before that she gets any part  
along with the rest of my Children viz. Theophilus Allison,  
Thomas Allison, Richard Allison, John Allison, and Magdalene  
Knox, Mary Herr, Ann Neal, and what Money there is to be  
equally divided among the above named Legates. I hereby  
appoint and constitute my Sons Theophilus & Thomas Allison  
Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this Eighth  
day of May 1794.
