have fifty pounds out of my Estate to pay for

236 Daughter my Horse Saddle & Bridle 7th I give and bequeath to Sarah Jarvis daughter to my 3^d Brother John Thompson the Confessor of faith if to be found or Renew his Letters 8th I give and bequeath to Mary M^c Knight daughter to William M^c Knight deceased one cow the choice of my stock I likewise give to Nancy M^c Knight & Marys mother one arm Chair 9th I give and bequeath to John Megawby Jun^r all his Notes of hand now in my possession & I allow him nothing more 10th I give and bequeath to Alexander Megawby Jun^r all Notes of hand now in my possession against him & I allow him no more 11th I give and bequeath to James Thompson son to Thomas Thompson Twenty pounds in Cash 12th I do order and it is my will that the remainder of my estate both Land and moveable property be sold at public Vendue and Equally divided amongst the following legatees male and female share and share alike Viz William Megawby James Megawby and their four Sisters but Mary Megawby I give one Spinning Wheel over & above ~~and~~ an equal divide also my Brother John Thompsons Son Alex^r Thompson and his four Sisters likewise my Brother Rob^t Thompson two sons James Thompson and John Brown Thompson & their three Sisters Viz Nancy M^c Knight

Pamela Thompson & Nelly Thompson & 13th and lastly I do appoint my Trusty friends and Neighbours John Harris and George Terman executors of this my last will & Testament and do by this Instrument of Writing Revoke disannul & make void all former Wills & Testaments by me made ratifying this and none else to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand affixed my seal this first day of August D 1804
