Daughter Mary Dobbins Daughter of John



knowing that it is appointed to all once to die & therefore I do make & ordain this as my  
last will & testament & first I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God &  
my body to receive a Christian Burial & that at the discretion of my Executor  
I leave & bequeath to my son Sam'l Edmonston one bay mare & saddle & bridle & lead  
Clothes & all my wearing Clothes & Cupboard & Kitchen furniture.

I also leave to my daughter Molly & Anna likewise to my son James & George  
Edmonston to each & every one the sum of 5 Shillings I leave my son Samuel Edmon-  
ston & old Mr Ewing as the executors of this my last will & testament And do  
hereby disallow & revoke & disanul all & every other former Testaments wills & geo-  
ries & Executors by me in any wise before named Ratifying & confirming this  
no other witness whereof I have hereunto set my Name and affixed my Seal
