In the name of God Amen

I Rebekah McCorkle, being in a sick & low state but in the  
proper exercise of reason I Judgment & calling to mind that it  
is appointed to all men once to die do commit my body to the  
dust to be buried at the discretion of my Executors, I my soul to God  
who gave it, hoping to receive the same against the resurrection  
of the Just. And as to the things of the world with which I  
hath pleased God to bless me I dispose of the same in the

following manner & form.

1<sup>st</sup> I give & bequeath to my step son Dr. Samuel McCorckle  
my Sorrel Slave.

2<sup>nd</sup> I give & bequeath to Sandy McCorckle Kilpatrick, a  
black Pett. 3<sup>rd</sup> I give to my step son Robert McCorckle one  
of his sheep. 4<sup>th</sup> I give to my son John McCorckle, three young  
heifers. It is my will that my clothes be divided among my  
Step Daughters & daughters in law by my last husband.

I give & bequeath to my step son Wm McCorckle one piece of  
Cotton Quilting Cloth.

I give to my son James McCorckle three sheep my books to be divide  
between Alexander, Robert & James except as mentioned hereafter.

I give to <sup>my</sup> mother Archibald Pippen's Hymns, I give to my step  
son Wm Brandon a large Bible a confession of faith, 3 or 4 Burton books  
together with twenty dollars in money.

I give to my step son John Brandon thirty five Dollars I give to

I give to my son Armstrong Brandon, one Stand of drawers, a new  
bed & pair of base sheets & one pair of fine, three blankets, a bed  
quilt, & one stand of curtains.

I give to my daughters in law Polly B. & Jean Brandon a  
number of porter dishes & plates also two boxes to be divided  
equally between them. I give to my son James McCorckle my  
cupboard together with ten pairs of window glass.

After funeral & other expences it is my will that the money

remaining in the hands of my executors be equally divided  
between my sons. Alexander, Joseph, William, James, my gran-  
dson Joel McCorkle I give to my grand daughter Rebecca McCorkle  
my other Bed & Bedding.

And further it is my will that all my household & Dreses furniture  
be sold & the money arising from the same be divided amongst  
my sons as directed above together with my son Robert, I Give  
to my daughter Catherine McCorkle receipt of Robin  
my Saddle.

And I Do hereby nominate & appoint my sons Job McCorkle  
& Armstrong Brandon, as Executors of this my last will  
& Testament hereby making void all other testaments  
by me made & declaring this as my last will & Testament  
in presence of us.
