In the name of God Amen
I Rebekah McCrable, being in a sick & low state but in the
proper exercise of reason & Judgment & calling to mind that I
am appointed to call more once to die do commit my body to the
dust to be buried at the discretion of my Executors, & my soul to God
who gave it, hoping to receive the same again at the resurrection
of the Just. And as to the things of the world with which I
hath pleased God to bless me I dispose of the same in the

1798
following manner I give.

1st I give I bequeath to my step son L^d Samuel M^r Corkle
my Sorrel Mare.

2nd I give I bequeath to Sandy M^r Corkle Kilpatrick, a

black Colt. 3^d I give to my step son Robert M^r Corkle ^{on} a

White sheep. 4th I give to my ^{Step} son J^m M^r Corkle, three young

heifers. It is my will that my clothes be divided among my
Step Daughters & Daughters in law by my last husband.

I give I bequeath to my step son W^m M^r Corkle one piece of
Cotton & woolen Cloth.

I give to my son James M^r Corkle three Sheep: my books to be divided
between Alexander, Robert, & James except as is mentioned hereafter.

I give to Martha Archibald Rippens Wymms, I give to my step

son W^m Brandon a large bible a confession of faith & a Psalm book,
together with twenty dollars in money.

I give to my step son John Brandon, thirty five Dollars I give to

I give to my ^{step} son Armstrong Brandon, one stand of drawers a new
bed & pair of Case Sheets & one pair of fine, three blankets, a bed
quilt, & one stand of Curtains.

I give to my daughters in law Polly B. & Jean A. Brandon a
number of pewter dishes & plates also two basins to be divided
equally between them. I give to my son James M^r Corkle my
Opolean together with ten pairs of window Glass.

After funereal & other expences it is my will that the money

remaining in the hands of my executors be equally divided
between my sons. Alexander, Joseph, William, & James, & my grand-
son Joel M'Corble, I give to my grand daughter Rebekah M'Corble
my other Bed & Bedding.

And further it is my will that all my household & Dress furniture
be sold & the money arising from the same be divided amongst
my sons as directed above together with my son Robert, & I Give
to my daughter Catherine M'Corble relict of John
my Saddle.

And I Do hereby nominate & appoint my sons Jo^l M'Corble
& Armstrong Brandon, as Executors of this my last will
& Testament hereby making void all other testaments
by me made & declaring this as my last will & Testament
in presence of us.
