I Richard Cook of the County of Fredell & State of North Carolina minister
of that Mortality common to all men & being of sound mind & memory make
on this the fifth day of April in the year eighteen hundred and forty seven & speak
in this my last will & testament in manner & form following.

In the first place to my beloved W^e Lucy I give for her use during her life &
or thereafter the sole use & benefit of my plantation on Hockley Creek on which I now
live & all my negroes Mill, Farming utensiles wagon orchards &c to my S^r W^e I
give & bequeath absolutely & to be at her disposal at the death the negroes following
I declare the children Nancy & Mary & her children Job Harmon little Jacob
Ned, Neal, violet & the children they or any of them may hereafter have.

My Stock of horses, cattle sheep & hogs I allow to the use of my S^r W^e Lucy so
far as she may choose to keep on the plantation giving to her & my other executors
the power to sell or dispose of any number she may not choose to keep & the money
arising therefrom to be reserved till the death of my wife & then by her divided as hereafter
directed. My money debts & every thing of the kind I allow to be kept by my executors un
til death of my wife then to be by her disposed of as hereafter directed.

The increase of my stock after my death & what ever may be the property of my
Wifes Industry with my hands on my plantation after my decease I allow to her
absolutely & entirely. My household Kitchen Furniture of every kind & description I
give to my said WIFE for her sole use & disposal. At the death or marriage of my S^r
Wife I allow my plantation on which I now live of six hundred & forty acres next
the track adjoining I purchased of Mr. Hughes to Richard Jones with the sum

90) Of my nephew John Cook & I do hereby Give & bequeath the S^d track of land on rocky
Creek being all the land I own to the S^d. Richard Jones Cook to him his heirs or assigns
forever at the death of my self. My money before mentioned with the following
Negroes, Dick, Jack, Wm, Simon, & Ben not willed absolutely to my wife, I allow
to dispose by my wife Lucy among our relatives of both sides as she may Judge proper
Night, by will or otherwise hereby declaring from & effectual all such dispositions of
my said wife Lucy. My Sister Lucy Clinton now living on the small tract
purchased of W^m Hughs Scallion the privilege of living on the S^d track &
continuing the same during her life if she chooses to continue thereon
Further I do hereby constitute & appoint my beloved wife Lucy Cook my brother
Thomas Cook my nephew John Cook & Richard King Executor of this my will
hereby revoking all former Wills, I declareing this to be my last will & testament
