Publish^{ed} this to be the last will & Testament in manner following

First, I desire all my Just debts & uncurrill charges to paid
Secondly, it is my will I desire after my decease that my beloved
wife shall have her living out of my Estate as long as she lives
a widow.

Thirdly, it is my desire that all my property shall remain
in the hands of my beloved wife Esther Dobson & my beloved son
John Dobson, Fourthly to be my Administrators. If they think
proper to make sale of my property to do so I if not to keep the
Property in their ^{own} hands for the ^{use of} rest of the family.

Fifthly, it is my desire that my Children shall be kept together
untill they come of ^{age} to act for them selves. Sixthly, when the
Young Child comes of age for them all to have an equal
part of my Estate personal & real if the administrators do not
make sale before it is my desire for it to remain then
